



As part of the ongoing commitment to the regeneration of Dromore, Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council will be delivering a Public Realm Scheme, which will provide high quality improvements within the Dromore Town Centre Conservation Area which includes outer Market Square, Bridge Street and Church Street.

The aim of the Dromore Town Centre Public Realm Scheme is to enhance the streetscape, improving accessibility and offer high quality design, using natural materials with bespoke details to reflect the town's unique history and Conservation Area designation. The scheme plans to introduce new pavement treatments, lighting, enhanced shared space, street furniture, signage and decorative features designed to complement the previous works around Dromore Town Hall.

Armagh City Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council have been working with GM Design Associates Limited, to develop these Concept Design Proposals and we would welcome your views. Following your feedback GM Design Associates Limited will develop the design proposals to submit a planning application.

It is anticipated that the construction works will commence on site in January 2021 and will last approximately nine months.

The selected concept images below provide examples of the approach that GM Design Associates Limited are considering in terms of potential paving materials, lighting, historic features and tree planting that could be used on this scheme. We would welcome your views on the style of this approach for the Dromore Town Centre Public Realm Scheme.

 Heritage style lighting
 The history of Dromore could be celebrated through sculpture
 New benches could feature stories of the history of Dromore
 Warm colours of Italian Porphyry paving could be used to compliment the existing works to the inner part of Market Square
 Engraved paving could be used to celebrate the historic businesses, shops or stories at certain locations within the town centre.
 Street names can be engraved into the new paving
 Occasional new signs could feature braille and raised features to aid visually impaired pedestrians around the town.
